• Current or former State Attorneys, Assistant State Attorneys, Statewide Prosecutors, or Assistant Statewide Prosecutors
• Current or former County and Municipal Code Inspectors and Code Enforcement Officers
• General Magistrates, Special Magistrates, Judges of Compensation Claims, Administrative Law Judges of the Division of Administrative Hearings and Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officers
• Current or former United States Attorneys and Assistant United States Attorneys
• Current or former Guardians Ad Litem, as defined in S.39.820
• Current or former Juvenile Probation Officers and other personnel of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
• Certain personnel of any local government agency or water management district whose duties include hiring and firing employees, labor contract negotiation, administration or other personnel-related duties.
