Appeals

<u>Motor Vehicle Appeals</u> – Mr. Sammons presented five vehicle appeals to the Board. Mr. Parker made a motion to approved the appeals. Mr. Turner second. 2023 CUVA and FLPA Productivity Ratings - Mr. Sammons presented the CUVA and FLPA Productivity Ratings for 2023 received from The Georgia Department of Revenue. Mr. Posey motioned to approve and implement the schedules. It was seconded by Mr. Parker. Motion carried.
