COMMISSIONERS' MEETING ROOM

Coffee County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, August 5, 2019, at 10:07 o'clock a.m. with the following present: Chairman Jimmy Kitchens, Vice-Chairman Johnny Wayne Jowers, Commissioners AJ Dovers, Ted O'Steen and Oscar Paulk. Also present were County Attorney Tony Rowell, County Administrator Wesley Vickers and County Clerk Tracie Vickers.

Chairman Kitchens called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Commissioner Dovers asked County Attorney Tony Rowell to give the invocation. Everyone participated in the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Chairman Kitchens welcomed our new County Commissioner, District # 5, Mr. Ted O'steen.

Chairman Kitchens announced the annual 2019 Legislative Leadership Conference will be held on October 2-4 at the Classic Center in Athens, GA.

Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the pre-meeting work session and regular meeting held on July 15, 2019, Special Called meeting held on July 19, 2019 and the Joint Meeting held on July 23, 2019. Commissioner Jowers made a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Dovers made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

Ms. Wynetta Bolder, City Clerk, presented the Mayors Youth Council. Ms. Bolder also explained how the Teen Court works. The Teen Court consist of 6th grade through 12th grade students. Ms. Bolder stated if anyone knows of someone that would like to participate in the Teen Court or the Mayors Youth Council to please contact her. The Commission expressed their appreciation to these youth and their dedication on these committees.

County Administrator Vickers reviewed the bids received by the County for (8) patrol cars. The bids received were:

Woody Folsom -2019 Dodge Charger AWD- \$24,600.00
Akins Dodge Jeep Chrysler – 2019 Dodge Charger AWD - \$24,981.75

Mr. Vickers recommends the low bid from Woody Folsom for \$24,600.00. These cars will be paid for from SPLOST VI funds. Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to accept or reject the purchase of (8) patrol cars. Commissioner Paulk made a motion to accept the low bid of \$24,600.00 from Woody Folsom. Commissioner Jowers seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

County Administrator Vickers reviewed the bids received for 2019 LMIG Project for Drainage, Base and Surfacing Improvements to Beaver Kreek Road. The bids received were:

Burke Paving Company - \$146,596.11
Allen Owens Construction & Paving, Inc. - \$146,854.75
East Coast Asphalt, LLC- \$181,702.38
Thrift Brothers, LLC -\$212,918.10

Mr. Vickers stated there is a letter of recommendation enclosed from the Engineer for the low bid of \$146,596.11 from Burke Paving Company. Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to approve or reject the bids for Beaver Kreek Road. Commissioner Jowers made a motion to accept the low bid from Burke Paving Company for \$146,596.11. Commissioner Dovers seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

County Administrator Vickers reviewed the bids received for 2019 LMIG project for Street and Drainage improvements to Willow Way. The bids received were:

Allen Owens Construction and Paving, Inc. - \$267,070.20
East Coast Asphalt LLC -\$305,018.06
Douglas Electric & Plumbing Company, Inc. - \$309,427.80
Thrift Brothers, LLC - \$309,588.75

Mr. Vickers stated there is a letter of recommendation from the Engineer enclosed recommending Allen Owens Construction and Paving for \$267,070.20. Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to approve the bids for Willow Way. Commissioner Dovers made a motion to approve the low bid from Allen Owens Construction and Paving, Inc. for \$267,070.20. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

There were no comments from the audience.

Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to adjourn the Regular Meeting. Commissioner Dovers made a motion to adjourn the regular meeting at 10:18 a.m. o'clock. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.
