Coffee County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Friday, January 14, 2022 at 11:00 o'clock a.m. with the following present: Chairman AJ Dovers, Vice-Chairman Ted O'Steen Commissioners Jimmy Kitchens, Johnny Wayne Jowers and Oscar Paulk. Also present were County Attorney Tony Rowell, County Administrator Wesley Vickers, and County Clerk Tracie Vickers.

Chairman Dovers called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

Attorney Rowell read the Resolution to fix and publish the qualifying Fees for the FY 2022 Election.
