COMMISSIONERS' MEETING ROOM

Coffee County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 15, 2018, at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with the following present: Chairman AJ Dovers, Commissioners Jimmy Kitchens, Johnny Wayne Jowers and Oscar Paulk. Also present were County Attorney Tony Rowell, County Administrator Wesley Vickers and County Clerk Tracie Vickers. Vice Chairman Charles Deen was absent.

Chairman Dovers called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Commissioner Kitchens asked Assistant Road Superintendent Wendell Troupe to give the invocation. Everyone participated in the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Chairman Dovers announced the ACCG Regional Meeting will be held on Thursday, October 25th at the Atrium from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Early voting will be October 15th through November 2nd from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. There will also be early voting on Saturday October 27th from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Coffee County has been awarded the COPS SVPP Grant funds for the estimated amount of \$468,537.00

The Southern Georgia Regional Commission annual area official's appreciation evening will be held on Thursday, October 18th at 6:00 p.m. at Dinnermans Farm in Adel, Georgia.

Chairman Dovers asked for approval of the minutes of the pre-meeting work session and regular meeting held on October 1, 2018 Commissioner Paulk made a motion to accept the minutes. Commissioner Jowers seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

Chairman Dovers asked for approval of the agenda. Commissioner Kitchens made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Jowers seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

County Administrator Vickers stated we have the Intergovernmental agreement between Coffee County, City of Ambrose, City of Broxton, and the City of Nicholls for the management of State Aide Road Resurfacing projects. Mr. Vickers stated this is the same agreement we have approved the past several years. Coffee County will be reimbursed 2 ½% of the contract price. Mr. Vickers has contacted the Mayor of each City and they have requested Coffee County to continue to administer their LMIG contract. Chairman Dovers asked for a motion to accept or reject this Intergovernmental agreement. Commissioner Jowers made a motion to approve this Intergovernmental Agreement. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.

Mr. Steve Carver, Fire Chief, stated Coffee County was blessed with minimal damage from Hurricane Michael. Our local shelter housed approximately 200 – 250 people. Coffee County

resident's power has been restored at this time. Mr. Carver thanked the citizens of Coffee County for abiding by the curfew and for their support.

Chairman Dovers asked if there were any comments from the audience. There were no comments.

Chairman Dovers asked for a motion to adjourn the Regular Meeting. Commissioner Kitchens made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:38 a.m. Commissioner Kitchens seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.
