Coffee County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 7, 2019, at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with the following present: Chairman Jimmy Kitchens, Vice-Chairman Johnny Wayne Jowers, Commissioners AJ Dovers, Oscar Paulk and Ted O'Steen. Also present were County Attorney Tony Rowell, County Clerk Tracie Vickers and County Administrator Wesley Vickers.

Chairman Kitchens asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the pre-meeting work session and regular meeting held on September 16, 2019. Commissioner Dovers made a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. All Commissioners unanimously agreed.
