Opening Ceremonies

Chairman, Dravian McGill Sr., called the meeting to order at 7:59 a.m. A quorum was declared and the following Board members were present: Dravian McGill Sr, Arthur Parker, William Turner (Via Telephone), and Brenda D. Booth. Chief Appraiser Sean Sammons, Appraiser Shaveta Harper, and Deed Specialist Heather Hurt Bloodsworth were also present. Arthur Parker gave the invocation for the meeting.

Approval of Minutes – The minutes of the Board meeting conducted on June 4th, 2025 were presented. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Parker and seconded by Ms. Booth. All were in favor.

Board Secretary- Mr. Sammons presented Heather Hurt Bloodsworth to the Board and recommended that she fill the remaining term vacancy for Board Secretary. A motion to approve the recommendation was made by Mr. Posey and seconded by Mr. Parker. All were in favor.

Appeals

Vehicle appeals – No vehicle appeals were received in the last month. It was reported that the tax commissioner's office completed a vehicle appeal. The Board discussed possible action moving forward for vehicle appeals.

CUVA Applications – Mr. Sammons shared that the notices were mailed and the appeal period has begun and that the last day to submit an appeal is July 25th. Ms. Booth motioned to approve the applications. Mr. Posey seconded. All were in favor.

Homestead Applications - The office has received 23 homestead applications consisting of 1 S-5, 15 L-1, and 7 S-1 applications. Ms. Booth motioned to approve the applications subject to additional research at the time of entry. Mr. Posey seconded. All were in favor.

Exempt Property Digest – Mr. Sammons presented the 2025 Exempt Property Digest. Mr. Posey motioned to approve the exempt status Ms. Booth seconded. All were in favor.

Education Update – Mr. Sammons shared that Melissa Reed, Dravian McGill Sr., and Mr. Turner recently attended CAVEAT for continuing education.

Other Business - Mr. Sammons introduced Shaveta Harper as our newest appraiser to join the team and informed the Board the Mrs. Reed' resignation. Mr. Sammons shared with the Board that we will be having our 3-Year Review with Georgia Department of Revenue today.
