In addition, all attendees should already have the 2024 edition of USPAP Standards Book from the last update cycle. If not, a digital or printed copy may be purchased directly from The Appraisal Foundation for \$25.00 each.

Each attendee is responsible for downloading the required materials in advance and arriving prepared with a laptop, tablet, or printed copies. Cell phones may be used, if necessary, though printing is strongly recommended.

Please ensure that you email [reab@llr.sc.gov](mailto:reab@llr.sc.gov) to get the code to download the free copies of the GRM and Student Workbook. These files are watermarked and each student must have their own copy.

There will be a limited number of chromebooks available for students to use in class for those who do not have a laptop or tablet, but have their watermarked copy downloaded to a thumb drive.

## MEMORANDUM

**TO:** All County Assessors

**FROM:** SCAAO

**SUBJECT:** Mandatory Valuation Bias and Fair Housing Laws and Regulations Course

Effective January 1, 2026, all new appraisal apprentices will be required to complete an eight-hour qualifying education (QE) course, *Valuation Bias and Fair Housing Laws and Regulations*, an AQB-approved course. Additionally, all licensed appraisers, including mass appraisers in South Carolina, must complete the seven-hour version of this course before renewing their licenses by June 30, 2026.

Following this initial requirement, all appraisers must complete **at a minimum** a four-hour refresher course every two years, identical to the seven-hour USPAP Update requirement.

### **AQB Course Requirements:**

- The first time an appraiser completes this continuing education requirement, the course length must be **seven (7) hours**.
- If an appraiser has already completed a **seven-hour (plus one-hour exam) QE course**, they have met this initial requirement. Every two years thereafter, appraisers must complete **at least a four (4) hour** course.
- Moving forward, SCAAO will offer the 7 hour course so all CE credits are covered each cycle.

### **Course Description:**

This mandatory course explores the critical issue of valuation bias in real estate, emphasizing practical case studies and strategies for recognizing and mitigating bias. While providing an overview of real estate bias and federal fair housing laws, the course focuses on the historical and contemporary impacts of valuation disparities, the role of various industry stakeholders, and best practices for fair property valuation. Participants will gain a deeper understanding of structural, implicit, and explicit biases and learn how to apply legal and ethical principles to promote equitable real estate practices.
